Tickhill village is approached by the


- A60 from Worksop

St Mary's C of E Church (DN11 9ND) is located on Church Lane.

Take Rawson Road off Westgate (A60), turn right onto Pinfold Lane. The church is on the right. Parking is available if you continue onto St Mary's Road. Car park on the right.

Tickhill is a pretty village with various shops and tea rooms where any audience members could spend some time during the day. There is Lottie's Coffee and Wine bar and The Lofthouse just across the road. The duck pond offers pleasant walks where Tickhill Castle can be found and there is a garden centre with a coffee shop just outside the village. Bawtry is only 4 miles away and Doncaster about 8 miles.

He has always been a keen choral singer, becoming a Lay Clerk at St Anne's R C Cathedral in Leeds and currently sings with The Metropolitan Cathedral and Basilica of St Chad Birmingham. David is now much in demand as a choral conductor and singer throughout the U K and Europe and is a private singing and brass teacher. David is also co-founder and Choral Animateur of the St. Chad's Choral Outreach Programme in Birmingham, a lecturer and conductor at Birmingham Junior Conservatoire and he has been Musicianship Leader for Opera North's 'In Harmony' programme, which was awarded Best Classical Music Education Initiative at the Classic FM Music Awards 2014. David was appointed as Director of Music of the Ryton Chorale in September 2013; he is also Director of Music of the Arrow Vale Singers in Redditch, a post he has held since 2012, and a choral leader for the Armonico Consort.
